Declaration: Main applicant and his/her common-law spouse have been living together as a married couple for more than two years. It requires two witnesses aged 18 or above to testify the authenticity and to have forensic examination of handwriting for verification (<i>original, issued by IPIM, valid for one month of the declaration</i>). 2. Document stating the marital status of the main applicant and his/her spouse in their original nation/region (<i>original, with at least six months of validity</i>)

Certified copy of birth certificate by hospital. ● For people born in another country/region: Birth certificate (<i>copy</i>) ◆ For biological children of ex-spouse(s) or illegitimate children, divorce document(s) and child custody document issued by official department(s) are required (<i>copy</i>) (<i>e.g. court adjudication</i>).

Adoption certificate (<i>original</i>) 2. Certified copy of adoption registration 3. Certificate of continuous adoptive relationship (<i>original, issued by county-level department</i>) ● For people who adopt the child in another country/region: Full set of documents relevant to the adoption in the country where the adoption is made (<i>copy</i>)

Criminal record certificate acquired in the original nation/region (<i>original, with at least six months of validity, applicable to children over 16 during the temporary residency</i>) 2. Criminal record certificate (<i>original, issued by the Macao SAR Identification Department within three months</i>)

<input type="checkbox"/> Property registration certificate (<i>Original, issued by the Real Estate Registry. For mortgaged property, repayment record specifying the remaining amount of loan issued by the creditor bank within a month</i>)
<input type="checkbox"/> Commercial registration certificate (<i>Original, issued by the Commerce and Movable Property Registry within three months, if applicable</i>).
<input type="checkbox"/> Time deposit document (<i>Original, only applicable to people who filed applications based on Administrative Regulation No 3/2005</i>).

The document should be issued by a credit institution in the Macao SAR and it must state that the deposit has never been withdrawn)

Proof of relation to Macao and proof of address

Anything addressed to the main applicant (*copy, e.g. water, electricity and telecommunication bills, monthly bank statement*)

Proof of spouse's relation to Macao (*copy, e.g. Macao employment certificate*) (*if applicable*)

Proof of relation of parents of applicant (or his/her spouse) to Macao (copy) (if applicable)

School attendance certificate of children issued by a Macao school (*copy*)(*if applicable*)

Remark:

- (1) Information on the application form should be consistent with that on the supporting documents. In an applicant is unable to provide supporting documents, he/she must submit a declaration to explain about it. Photos submitted should not be the same as the photos previously submitted.
- (2) Certificates and documents acquired in Mainland China should be issued by notary office in Mainland China within six months.
- (3) Original documents must be presented for verification when submitting copies of the above listed documents.
- (4) Pursuant to Paragraph 2 under Article 9 of Administrative Regulation No 3/2005, regardless of application grounds, IPIM may reasonably request applicants to submit further documents which might facilitate the application assessment.
